## QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

#### Q: How do I get involved in helping the club to grow?

A: We currently have open positions on our board of directors. We would love some new board members! Volunteering is an important need for our club. We rely on our volunteers to keeps things running smoothly and keep the costs down. Ask our President, Burton Powley how you can help. *Please check your email frequently for volunteer requests and important notices in your email box.* 

#### Q: How do I get private lessons?

A: Speak to one our coaches. Private lessons are a good way to improve particular skills or prepare for competitions & shows.

#### Q: How often should I skate?

A: 3 times a week is best to show steady progress.

#### Q: Where do I buy skates?

A: Ask Coach Burton or Elena. Good used skates are available and we have catalogs for new ones. Skaters learn faster and safer on better equipment.

#### Q: How often should I sharpen my skates? And where?

A: Skates should be sharpened about every other month to wear evenly and prevent rust. If you see any signs of rust, have them sharpened as soon as possible to protect your investment. Coach Burton sharpens skates for \$10. Or ask Coach Igor for his pricing and availability.

We know there has been a lot of changes being made recently. Especially regarding Ice Ticket Purchase Policies and New Learn to Skate Coaches and curriculum.

The club policy going forward regarding parents on the ice or in the coaches/players boxes during freestyle times is as follows:

Only those parents that are using video technology lesson with an APPROVED coach are allowed in the coaches/players boxes. This is to eliminate distractions from those doing lessons with a coach and those in practice. If you wish to put on skates and participate or supervise small children, then you are allowed if you pay for ice time. However, all the coaches and board members agree this is what they will allow.

We appreciate your patience while we work towards improving the experience for all skaters. We want this to be safe and fun experience for everyone.

We have board meetings every month. Any member is welcome to attend and offer suggestions. And participate in the discussion.
